

## Frequently Asked Questions about PRL Databases

### 1. How do I get to Pamunkey Regional Library's databases?

Go to [www.pamunkeylibrary.org](http://www.pamunkeylibrary.org). Click on Alphabetical Database List or Database List by Subject in the menu on the left of the page under "Find Magazine Article and More."

### 2. I don't have a PRL library card. Can I still use the databases?

You'll need to have a parent or guardian sign for your library card before you can use any of the databases.

### 3. Can I use all of the databases at home?

All of the databases are available from home or school, except for Ancestry.com Library Edition.

### 4. How do I cite the information I find on the databases?

Several of our databases will create citations in different formats for you. Ask a staff member or Reference Librarian to show you how to use this feature or see our style manuals in the Reference section at any branch library.

### 5. How do I know that the information I find is accurate?

The information in each of our databases is reviewed by librarians, editors, and other trusted experts. If you find information that is not accurate, please let a staff member know.

### 6. What databases are available?

In addition to the Find It Virginia databases you have at school, Pamunkey Regional Library also has access to Ancestry.com Library Edition, p4a Antiques, Auto Repair Reference Center, Britannica Online, Britannica Kids, HeritageQuest, Literature Criticism Online, NoveList Plus, The Richmond Times-Dispatch Archives, Salem Health, Salem History, Teen Health & Wellness, Testing and Education Reference Center, and WilsonWeb.
