What We Learned

Projects like this used creative thinking skills, improved teamwork, built on what they explored earlier, and maintained interest through regular updates.

Challenges included creating unique projects and third-party application limitations. The Project Fair was too informal for some and it also created a time crunch as the staff day planners scrambled to get projects up and running

Benefits to the library, its staff and our patrons, included experience beyond looking at a "2.0" web site or application, better customer service, increased knowledge about our collection, and more efficient use of resources

Beyond 20 Things

20 Things...

From October 2007 to April 2008, during our 20 Things project, staff were invited to experiment with Web 2.0 applications and consider how they impact libraries. In Beyond 20 Things, we took that idea a step further and asked staff to create practical projects for both staff and patrons.

...and Beyond!

Proposal forms were distributed to each branch/department in October 2008. Each group was asked to do the following:

- Provide a project summary
- Specify which Web 2.0 tool(s) would be used
- Describe how the project would benefit its target audience
- Create a task outline to track the project's progress
- List the resources and/or equipment needed

Proposal drafts were submitted to the Supervising Librarians and the Director for revision and final approval. Work began on the projects, to be finished by April 15.

Beyond 20 Things Project Fair

At our annual Full Staff Day in May, we held a Beyond 20 Thing project fair. Each staff member or visitor had a "passport" listing each project. Stations for each project were set up in the library for everyone to see. Once he or she "visited" a project, the passport would be stamped in the appropriate place by the exhibitor. Prizes were awarded to those who got their passports filled!
