# 1. Call to Order/ Welcome

M. Shipman called the meeting to order at 9:10a.m. and welcomed all who were in attendance.

### 4. Old Business

A. Audit

M. Shipman welcomed Greg Miller, CPA and Director at Cherry BekaertLLP. Cherry Bekaert<sup>LLP</sup>, CPAs & Advisors is the external auditor for the library as well as Hanover County. G. Miller spoke about Cherry's audit of PRL's FY2021 financial statements.

G. Miller distributed a document which described the overall services that Bekaert<sup>LLP</sup> has provided for the audit. He stated that they looked at both FY2020 and FY2021 and he walked the committee through the document on the audit that is being provided. The opinion of Bekaert<sup>LLP</sup> is that the 2021 financial statements are anticipated to be unmodified.

J. May complimented T. Shepley, K. Catron, and G. Miller for keeping eyes on the PRL finances and all present agreed.

### **5.** New Business

#### **A. Collection Development**

T. Shepley distributed a document describing the acquisition of library materials which also included a copy of the PRL "Request for Reconsideration of Library Materials" which can be used by the public to submit in writing a concern about any material that is part of the PRL collection. The response to any submitted concern comes from the PRL staff.

#### **B.** Freedom to Read

T. Shepley distributed the "Library Bill of Rights" which was developed and adopted on June 18, 1948 by the American Library Association (ALA). It was slightly amended in 1961, 1980, and 1996. Also distributed was "The Freedom to Read Statement" from the ALA which originated in 1953 and the "Libraries: An American Value" statement from the ALA adopted on February 3, 1999. After a brief review of these documents, T. Shepley stated that the PRL adheres to these statements.
